The Alliance Center, a one-hundred year-old warehouse in Lower Downtown Denver, demonstrates a hub for a state-based sustainability movement with thirty non-profit tenants. Tenants, partners and community members use the building as a tool for collaboration, education and social advocacy. It is one of two buildings in the world to receive two Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design certifications from the US Green Building Council – LEED Gold for Existing Buildings and LEED Silver for Commercial Interiors. The Center received Energy Star Leader certification.

Over 50 signs and displays highlight the collaborative, green and historic features throughout the Alliance Center.

Learn about the research project on the “Green Roof” and other energy saving techniques used in this very modern LEED building.

Security is tight and you will be guided through the EPA building by a tour docent.

The EPA building tour will include their beautiful atrium, the multi-story water feature, the lighting system for the entire building, the heating/cooling system for the building, the use of renewable resources used throughout the building and the famous “green roof” project.
